The South Jersey Shore Clay Tour , March 29th – 31st, 2010

The South Jersey Shore Clay Tour (SJSCT) will consist of eleven venues with a total of fourteen exhibitions throughout a six county area of Southern New Jersey during the months of March and April, 2010. This tour will be a pre-conference event in conjunction with the 2010 National Council for Education in the Ceramic Arts (NCECA) conference in Philadelphia (March 31st – April 3rd, 2010).

The SJSCT mission is to attract national and local attention to the ceramic/art scene of Southern New Jersey, as well as, like-minded art institutions, artists, art collectors and clay enthusiasts together. The objective is to create a better network among institutions for better serving the community, help strengthen current existing systems and create more opportunities for visual arts during these difficult economic times.

The tour will be self-guided throughout the eleven sites in the state starting in Collingswood, Perkins Center for the Arts/Collingwood, Sewell, Gloucester County College, Glassboro, Rowan University, Millville, with the Riverfront Renaissance Center for the Arts, The Clay College and Wheaton Arts. Next stop will be Atlantic Cape May Community College in Mays Landing followed with the Noyes Museum in Oceanville and then up to the Richard Stockton College of New Jersey in Pomona. The tour will wrap up with Long Beach Island's m.t.burton gallery and Long Beach Island Foundation of the Arts and Sciences. All the venues will be hosting an exhibition or have an open clay studio.

The dates for each exhibition will vary.
